Membership dues

It is proposed to raise the annual dues for 2010 to 50 Canadian dollars per person









- Reasons for increasing membership dues
- Regular expenditure administration fee, audit, ASTIN Bulletin, bank charges, etc CAD 10,000
- Share of IT person in IAA secretariat CAD 4,000
- Representation at ISSA CAD 1,500 say
- Outgoings nearly CAD 16,000 a year
- Income at CAD 40 = CAD 16,000 a year
